
Through the devotions, teachable moments, and camp talk, <u>35 campers prayed to receive the free gift of salvation</u>...Praise God!

Below is what one of those campers, a tenyear-old girl, wrote in her camp evaluation:

This past summer, **763 kids spent time** at camp. **107 of them received** scholarship assistance. One needed just \$100. In a few cases of hardship, full scholarships, up to \$685, were provided.

None of this would be possible without the generous support of people like you.
